INSPIRATIONS

The Swiss Programme for Research on Global Issues for Development (r4d programme) has funded more than 20 research projects in 9 countries of West Africa from 2014 to 2021 and follow-up initiatives are ongoing. Representatives of these r4d projects will participate in the r4d Science Fair West Africa to present their findings in a "research market place". ABOUT THE R4D PROGRAMME

The r4d programme is a joint funding initiative by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) and the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF). The r4d programme supports research aimed at solving global problems with a focus on least developed, low- and middle income countries. A total budget of CHF 97.6 million was available for the duration of the programme from 2012 to 2022.

The r4d programme fund reseach contributing to sustainable development, particularly in the thematic areas of Public Health, Employment, Social Conflicts, Ecosystems Management, Food Security. About 60 transnational research partnership projects are carried out by research groups of more than 290 grantees in 50 countries.
