
Use of research knowledge by society



Research knowledge is often not used by practitioners and other societal actors. We found that dissemination by non-academic project partners or champions and via television is associated

KEY MESSAGES:

with higher Research Knowledge Utilisation, while dissemination by scientific project partners and via peer-reviewed journals is associated with lower use.

- Promoting use of research knowledge can help reduce the science-practitioners gap in research on socio-ecological systems.
- We need to rethink the role of non-academic partners in the design and governance of research for development projects.

Solutions to overcome barriers to use of research knowledge

- Early and active stakeholder involvement
- Identification of champions
