


Land Commercialisation, Gendered Agrarian Transformation, and the Right to Foo

Objective

Increase dialogue among communities, civil society, policy-makers and land acquisition firms on the right to food and gender equality approaches to food security

Two-country longitudinal livelihood and change scenario design at household, national and international levels includes legal and gender sensitive analysis of human rights instruments



Scientific and development relevant contributions include a new body of evidence on laws and policies on right to food, gender equality, livelihoods and land commercialisation. Training, dialogues, legal and policy briefs plus a short film and public website.
