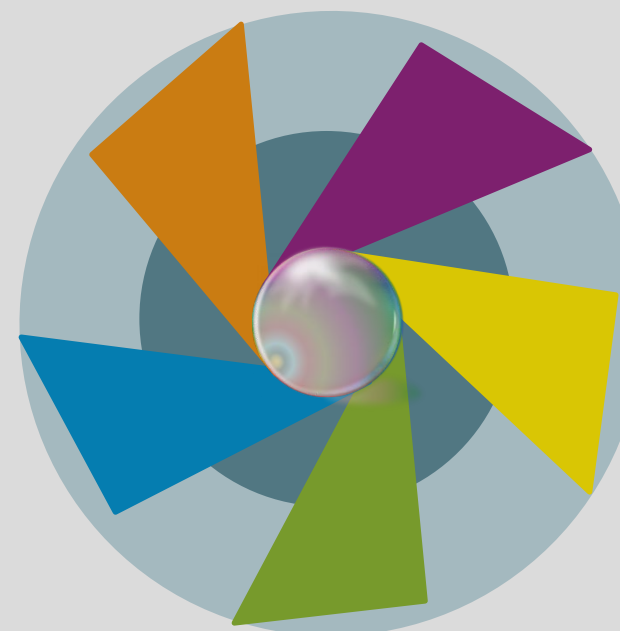

SYNTHESIS PROCESS

Synthesis questions and hypotheses
Pre-synthesis workshops

Multiple synthesis sub-projects tailored by research teams, review panels and the r4d steering committee

The methodological approach endorsed by the r4d steering committee defines the synthesis questions and paves the way for the preliminary hypotheses that will be tailored during the pre-synthesis workshops (module level).



During the pre-synthesis workshops we agree on as many synthesis sub-projects as needed. We explore these sub-projects, address the synthesis questions and test the synthesis hypotheses with active involvement of stakeholders and researchers. Incentives for participation can be monetary and non-monetary.

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
