Storytelling in a pitch

Explaining an idea in a short and convincing way is the means of film directors or start-ups to find investors. 'Pitching' is increasingly used by scientists to communicate complex research to a broader audience.

The r4d programme wants to motivate young scientists to reach out to academics as well as non-academics by communicating their research insights in an engaging and enjoyable manner. It has recently launched a call for three-minute video pitches, which is open to PhD candidates of r4d projects.

To support you in preparing a video pitch, the r4d programme organises a series of Storytelling webinars. Within a short time you can learn how to create your story and how to deliver it (without using PowerPoint).

The webinars are organised on four different dates and at different times in order to enable participation from all continents. The online tools will be easily accessible for all users.
