Revisiting agroecology

The systemic nature of agroecology (AE) and its contribution to multiple SDGs are among the outstanding arguments for AE. But skepticism prevails regarding its economic viability.

Donors and implementers alike call for research that demonstrates the productivity and economic viability of AE on a larger scale. The study "Swiss-Funded Agricultural Research for Development (AgR4D) – Dawn of an Agroecological Transition?" sheds light on the money flow and provides interesting recommendations for strengthening AE.

The Food Systems Caravan West Africa put agroecology and systems thinking at the core of its approach. It was on tour from September to November 2019 and provided a unique opportunity of moving a coordinating multimedia team along the road from Bamako, Mali, to Ibadan, Nigeria, where r4d partner institutions and field sites were present throughout. The team documented ongoing research activitives, organised events and promoted a cross-project and cross-country learning process. From the Food Systems Caravan emerges a documentary targeting interesting stakeholders in the food system as well as the general public.
